Guidelines for Large Band Instruments on the bus

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation mandates in 67 Pa Code 171.58, that the interior of a school bus must be free of objects which can cause injury. Objects must be secured, and the aisles and emergency exits open and free of blockage. The following must be adhered to at all times:

- 1. Large band instruments or school project items are not permitted on the bus unless they can be held on the student's lap.
- 2. Items may not be placed under seats, they can become projectiles upon impact.
- 3. Nothing can be placed in the driver's compartment/doorway or aisle.

Below is a list of band instruments developed by the schools Music Dept's in conjuntion wind Transportation that are allowed and not allowed to be transported on the bus.
